Rome, 8th June 2011

Attaining the Millennium Development Goals [MDGs] is inextricably linked to policies, programmes and projects that bring about socially inclusive and equitable sustainable development. A key driving force for attaining sustainable development and food security is the process of open innovation, which constitutes the motor of the development process, while ensuring social inclusion for building durable social capital.

A central element of the open innovation process is the principle of co-design for promoting broad partnerships of all the stakeholders concerned with the future of rural populations. It engenders the emergence of new forms of collaboration and the behavioural transformation required to make the shift towards sustainable forms of human activity. This rural focus on open innovation was the objective of the recently-concluded EU-funded “Collaboration@Rural”¹ project and is at the basis for the “Social Spaces for Research and Innovation” network promoting Living Labs for innovative communities.

The aim of the 1st International Conference on Social Spaces for Research and Innovation Conference is to tap the potential for cooperation among the many partners participating in the Living Labs initiative worldwide, to broaden the partnership of actors and agencies interested in collaboration and promote synergies among the many existing initiatives involving open innovation and the Living Lab methodological approach.

The 1st International Conference on Social Spaces for Research and Innovation Conference is an opportunity for promoting the use of open innovation practices and know-how, including partnership-based monitoring and impact evaluation methodologies.

The 1st International Conference on Social Spaces for Research and Innovation Conference will focus on three main streams:

1. Open Innovation and Sustainable Development: A Living Labs Approach
2. Private-Public Partnerships: Social Responsibility and Sustainable Development
3. Social Spaces for Research and Innovation: A Platform for Social Inclusion

The Conference will be held on 8th June and will bring together the different stakeholders and partners in interactive sessions for elaborating specific open innovation topics.
